Set in the Gateway City on the eve of the World's Fair (which introduced America to such exciting innovations as the hot dog, ice cream cone, cotton candy, and Dr. Pepper), "Meet Me in St. Louis" is the Broadway version of the memorable 1944 MGM motion picture starring Judy Garland.

Directed by Peggy Dorsey and choreographed by Jesse Milan, this year's musical includes more than 60 talented adults, teens, and children from around the neighborhood and greater Baltimore, singing and dancing to such favorites as "The Trolley Song," "Skip to My Lou," "The Boy

Next Door," and more. A full orchestra includes musicians from the Peabody Institute, led by music director Dana Scott. Jamie Griffith is this year's producer, and sets are designed by John Seeley.

The city-wide Mayor's Clean-up day is April 20; it's a good time to clean up Bolton Hill, too. Everything that hits the ground and doesn't go into a container ends up in the Harbor and the Bay, so this is a good time to do a general pick up of debris. Midtown Community Benefits District will pick up large items, like tree branches.

Eradicate rats

Homeowners or tenants may call 311 and inform them that they have rats in either their front or back garden; the city will send someone out for FREE to come and place baits in the exterior areas where there is rat activity. Before you call "Rat Rub Out (311)" you have to fill out a release form that allows the city to enter your front or back yard before they will bait. The release form can be found on the internet: **baltimorehealth.org/info/rightofentry**. Just be aware that the baits can potentially harm birds, squirrels, pets and even children. Try removing food sources (garbage, animal waste, etc) before you take that drastic step. See the Community Guide for 2008-2009 for more.
